TOPIC: Selection and Use of Sterilisation Wraps

Fran will host a recorded presentation on the Selection and Use of Sterilisation Wraps by Terry McAuley, an Infection Prevention and Control Consultant who runs her own independent business STEAM Consulting. There will be an opportunity for live Q&A with Fran.

Fran was born and brought up in Adelaide, and trained as a Registered Nurse at The Queen Elizabeth Hospital and then completed midwifery studies in Melbourne.

Terry will describe the process for manufacturing non-woven sterilisation wraps, including the testing that is required for all sterilisation wraps.
